



## Win a Picasso for £10.10 Competition Terms and Conditions

- 1) STANDARD COMPETITION RULES
  - a) The **Win a Picasso for £10.10 Competition** (the "**Competition**") is open to residents of the United Kingdom aged eighteen (18) and over, other than employees of 10:10 (the "**Promoter**"), and their respective subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies and their immediate families (defined for the purpose of these Terms as husband, wife, mother, father, sister, brother, son, daughter, or persons residing in the household of such employees), and anyone else professionally connected with this Competition. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the eligibility of Entrants and check their identity.
  - b) All information detailing how to enter this Competition forms part of these terms and conditions.
  - c) Entrants will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions (the "**Terms**") when the Entrant enters the Competition as described in Paragraph 2 below.
- 2) HOW TO ENTER
  - a) The Competition will start at 1010 Greenwich Mean Time ("**GMT**") on November 5th 2009 and end at 1010 GMT on January 31st 2010 (the "**Competition Period**").
  - b) To be eligible to win the Prize, each entrant to the Competition (an "**Entrant**") must visit the competition website: [1010uk.org/picasso](http://1010uk.org/picasso) (the "**Website**"), and correctly answer the competition question (the "**Question**"), and pay the competition entry fee (the "**Entry Fee**"), and submit their name and contact details, (an "**Entry**").
  - c) The Entry Fee is £10.10, payable on submission of the Entry, and additional Entries will be accepted for each multiple of £10.10 paid by the Entrant.
  - d) By submitting an Entry, or multiple Entries, Entrants confirm that all information provided is true and accurate to the best of their knowledge and belief.
- 3) If any Entrant is determined by the Promoter to have breached these Terms, the Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any such Entrant. In the event that a Winner is disqualified, the Promoter will select an alternative Winner in accordance with the process described in Paragraph 7b and subject to all Terms set out herein.
- 4) RESTRICTIONS ON ENTRY
  - a) Entries received outside of the Competition Period will not be eligible to win a Prize.
  - b) Entries that are incomplete will be deemed invalid. No responsibility will be accepted by the Promoter for Entries lost, delayed or damaged in transmission.
- 5) HOW TO WIN
  - a) At 1030 GMT on January 31<sup>st</sup> 2010, one Entry will be chosen at random from those Entries submitted during the Competition Period, and which answer the Question correctly (the "**Prize Draw**"). The Entrant responsible for this Entry will be deemed the winner of the competition (the "**Winner**").
  - b) The Promoter's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into in respect of the Competition.
- 6) THE PRIZE
  - a) The prize under this Competition (the "**Prize**") shall be as follows:

- i) The Prize, which only the Winner shall be entitled to claim, shall be a linocut print (from the artist's original blocks) of *Vallauris-1956 Exposition* by Pablo Picasso. A full description of the Prize can be found at [1010uk.org/1010/picasso\\_info](http://1010uk.org/1010/picasso_info)
  - b) The Promoter will have fulfilled all of its obligations to the Winner in respect of the Prize upon delivery of the Prize to the Winner.
  - c) In the event that, due to reasons beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Prize cannot be delivered to the Winner, the Promoter may at its absolute discretion vary or amend the Prize offered under this Competition, provided that any alternative prize offered in replacement of the Prize shall be of equal or greater value than the original Prize.
  - d) No cash equivalent or alternative prize will be given, other than under the circumstances in Paragraph 6c, and the Prize is non-transferable and non-exchangeable.
- 7) NOTIFICATION
  - a) The Winner will be notified by email within ten (10) days of the Prize Draw.
  - b) If the Winner does not confirm acceptance of his/her Prize within ten (10) days of notification then the Winner will be deemed to have forfeited the Prize and the Prize Draw shall be repeated in order to select a new Winner. This process shall be repeated until a Winner claims the Prize.
  - c) Upon acceptance of the Prize the Winner will be contacted by the Promoter within ten (10) days with details of how to claim the Prize.
  - d) The Promoter reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to withhold delivery of the Prize until proof of eligibility and identity has been confirmed.
- 8) PRIVACY
  - a) Personal data submitted as part of an Entry to the Competition is subject to the 10:10 Privacy Policy, which is available at: <http://www.1010uk.org/html/legal.html>
  - b) Specifically, the personal data collected through this Competition will be used as follows:
    - i) To contact the Entrant to confirm their Entry
    - ii) To ascertain whether the Entrant has signed up to the 10:10 Campaign (and tailor the Entrant's confirmation message accordingly)
    - iii) To provide notification where the Entrant has won the Prize.
  - c) By entering this Competition an Entrant expressly consents to the use of the Entrant's personally identifiable information in accordance with the 10:10 Privacy Policy and to the use described in Paragraph 8b.
- 9) PUBLICITY
  - a) The Winner agrees to participate in publicity activities pertaining to the Competition, including interviews and appearances in photo and video content.
  - b) The Winner grants the Promoter and its partner organisations a perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free, and non-exclusive licence to reproduce, adapt, modify, translate, publish, publicly perform, publicly display and distribute anything arising from these activities to which the Winner could have a copyright claim.
  - c) The name and county of the Winner will be published at [1010uk.org](http://1010uk.org) following the Prize Draw and acceptance of the Prize by the Winner.
  - d) By entering this Competition the Entrant agrees to the Entrant's details being disclosed in the event that the Entrant is picked as a Winner.
- 10) GENERAL

- a) If any provision or part of these Terms is deemed void or otherwise unenforceable in law then that provision or part shall be deemed excluded and the remainder of these Terms shall remain in force.
- b) These Terms, the conduct of this Competition and the interpretation and enforcement of these terms and conditions shall be exclusively governed and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales, unless the Entrant is a Scottish resident, in which case the Entrant may choose the law of their own country of residence. Entrants irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales, unless they are a Scottish resident or a resident of Northern Ireland, in which case they may choose the courts of their place of residence.
- c) The Promoter cannot guarantee the performance of any third party and shall not be liable for any act or default by a third party. Entrants agree that the Promoter will have no liability whatsoever for any injuries, losses, costs, damage or disappointment of any kind resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly from acceptance, misuse or use of the Prize or from participation in this Competition. Nothing in this paragraph shall limit the Promoter's liability in respect of death or personal injury arising out of its own negligence or arising out of fraud.
